As a first step to registering a new customer we undertake a KYC process and request some documentation in order to verify a new business, this includes a questionnaire and business validation certificate of incorporation and proof of address)

As a second step in the IOSS Registration process with My Duty Collect, we undertake an internal process/risk analysis based on your company details

Once the KYC process is approved, we will send our Order Form and a copy of the IOSS Agreement (which includes the Bank Deposit section), Power Of Attorney Document, Agent Link Form & Billing Process



As an intermediary for IOSS, we are legally representing client companies, and the requested documentation helps to guide our onboarding and validation process
